# NEW BUSINESS

- 1. Triennial Review Report Presented by Danna Drum of OHA Public Health Division.
  - 1. The purpose of a triennial review is to ensure compliance with state and federal regulations and requirements related to public health funding.
  - 2. 15 different areas reviewed.
  - 3. Viewed as an opportunity to identify areas for improvement and areas of strength.
  - 4. Areas of strengths and areas for improvement were shared with the board.
  - 5. Overall, NCPHD is a very strong health district. Things are under control and the work is getting done. This is a tribute to Teri and her team.
  - 6. Comments / Feedback:
    - a. It was asked if the 15 areas reviewed ever change or are they always the same. Danna commented that it depends on what's in the contract; what NCPHD is receiving funding for that particular year that the review is being done in.
    - b. It was asked if any health department has ever failed a triennial review. *Danna commented that there have been situations where there are repeat findings over a period of time. There are very few reviews where there are no compliance findings. The state approaches the review as a partnership and opportunities for improvement. The state also likes to identify areas of strenath.*
  - 7. Danna also shared with the board information regarding public health modernization.
- 2. BMI Data Collected at Local Public Elementary Schools in Wasco County Presented by Dillon Melady
  - 1. Overall prevalence of overweight and obese children in The Dalles has not changed from 2014 to 2017.
  - 2. There has been a slight increase in obesity rates for boys and a slight decrease for girls.
  - 3. Compared to 2012 BMI data for all of Oregon, children in The Dalles are 7% more likely to be obese.
  - 4. Currently working on breaking down the data by grade level for each of the schools.
  - 5. Comments / Feedback:
    - a. It was asked what the cut off is between overweight and obese. *Dillon commented that overweight is between 85<sup>th</sup>-95<sup>th</sup>%ile and obese is anything above 95%ile.*
    - b. It was asked what the defining factors were for the high rates in The Dalles. *Dillion commented that there are many factors such as poverty levels; not being able to afford fruits and vegetables; on the west side of town there isn't a good supermarket close by; no sidewalks or safe walking paths; social economics for each school.*
    - c. Commissioner Hege would like to see a comparison of Wasco County vs. national BMI data.

- 6. Director's Report By Teri Thalhofer
  - 1. Domestic Well Grant
    - a. Date for receiving price discount for well water testing is August 10<sup>th</sup>.
    - b. We are no longer specifically targeting just people who may not be able to cover the cost of their own well testing; so anybody that wants to get their well water tested can support that over the next 5 weeks.
    - c. To date, we've supported testing of 25 domestic wells.
    - d. The focus has been in Sherman County.
  - At Oregon's epidemiology conference attended by some NCPHD staff they learned that Syphillis has risen in Oregon by 67% in the last 7 years; and in the last 2 or 3 years has risen 1100%. This is an emerging issue.
    Oregon's rates are higher and rising faster than the rest of the nation.
  - 3. Work is continuing on solar eclipse planning.
