**Subject:** Winter Safety Tips

With continued severe weather, North Central Public Health District would like to again share helpful information on ways to stay safe in extreme cold temperatures.

## Topline tips include:

- Check on your vulnerable family and neighbors
- Leave faucets on drip; open doors below sinks to allow warmer air to reach pipes
- Be prepared for power outages: keep a supply of blankets, non-perishable foods and a battery-powered radio on hand
